

Not illustrated. 1922 Excerpt: . . . by cutting out the poorest trees, thereby allowing the better ones to grow more naturally. Even in new planting, the trees are still being planted too closely. Three trees to the hundred feet, is the minimum spacing desirable. A distance of forty feet between trees is better. Close planting produces so much shade along the streets, that it is impossible to grow any satisfactory kind of turf in the parking strip. They should be staggered on opposite sides of the street. Parking Strips--The parking strips for trees should not be too narrow. Many trees develop trunks thirty-six inches and more in diameter, and the surface root systems spread out to at least double this distance. For proper ultimate growth, a width of six feet is not too much for the parking strip. Lesser widths force the sidewalks and curbs out of place. Trees will die if girdled on all sides by sidewalks or curbs. When planting a tree, a hole should be dug four feet square and four feet deep. This should be completely filled with good soil and the roots well spread out. With occasional cultivation, mulching and watering, the young tree will then get a proper start in life. GUTTERS Most of the streets have block stone gutters which, as a rule, are unsightly. They also prevent a rapid run-off of water. The volume of water in East Orange street gutters is large, on account of the great distance between drains. Leaves and other...
