

It has been found necessary for the convenient, and even for the practicable conduct of affairs, to accord, in some instances, a measure of legality to a status that, in strictness, is illegal. Thus in the feudal law of real property a disseisor in the possession of a freehold estate, enjoyed the rights of ownership and his heir the right of inheritance until the true owner recovered possession, a rule yet partly in force. A person in possession of chattels, though without title, has the prerogatives of title as against every one but the owner or those claiming under the latter. Governments founded by revolution or conquest are treated as lawful and their acts as valid, after they seem to be stable; and the actual incumbents of public offices, albeit without a true election or appointment, are regarded as so far entitled to their places as to render their acts valid. With the like hope of facilitating the transaction of business, courts have made use of this principle in the law of corporations, and thereby have introduced the doctrine of corporate...
